### **Sermon Series Discussion Questions - Week 4**

1. In the intro to this weeks message Pastor Tim spoke about guard rails and lane assist. How was this illustration helpful when relating to lust.
2. John Piper explains the kind of lust Jesus refers to in Matthew 5:27- 30 as “a sexual desire minus honor and holiness”. So why does lust degrade another person?
3. This type of lust does not refer to the 1st glance of recognition but to the 2nd, 3rd & 4th, it’s leering. How do you know when a glance of recognition turns into something else?
4. According to a Huffington Post article 1 out of 2 religious men and 3 out of 10 religious women are addicted to porn. Even if remotely accurate, how is this addiction affecting the church?
5. In Matthew 5:29-30 Jesus gets pretty graphic in his measures to stop lust. What does he suggest? What real life measures could we take to accomplish denying lust?
6. Even if someone gouged out their eye or cut off their hand, would that solve the problem of lust? Why?
7. According to Ephesians 5:3 how much lust is OK with God?
8. How can we master lust according to Matthew 6:33?
