## **OFF-SITE WEDDING POLICIES**

**Congratulations to both of you on having made one of the most significant decisions of your lives! ## **GENERAL WEDDING GUIDELINES**

**Either the bride or groom needs to be a member of Fresh Start Church (FSC). They should be an active member with consistent attendance. It is preferred that they are actively volunteering and using their gifts to contribute to the mission of FSC as well as contributing financially to the vision.**

FSC Pastors use an approved script for the wedding ceremony. It is the final decisions of the pastor to allow additions such as: extra scripture readings, poems or personal vows in the wedding ceremony. Such items must be reviewed by the pastor during the final counseling session.

### **PREMARITAL COACHING**

It is required that all couples, being married by a Fresh Start Church pastor, attend premarital coaching sessions with the pastor who will perform their ceremony.

### **\*Scheduling of Wedding Fees**

- Personnel Fees (Member & Non-Members) Non-negotiable
- Initial pre-marriage consultation, pre-coaching materials and pastors fees - \$500
  - Total off-site wedding fees are \$500

Fee schedule is non-negotiable for both member and non-members. Fees are payable in full one-month prior to the wedding date and may be paid by check, made payable to Fresh Start Church.
