

Week 8 (2/25/24) Moses

Send the Hornet

Read Deuteronomy 7:17

Why is it that our enemies always seem bigger and stronger than we are?
Red Sea Crossing
David with Goliath
Israelites Conquering the Promised Land

Discuss or have someone share an incident where you/they had to face something much bigger than you/them.

(Be sure to relay the idea that if our enemies/Giants weren't Big, we would never need God)

Just because you're moving towards God doesn't mean you're moving away from your enemies. What should change is your perspective (Natural v Supernatural).

Questions we ask in the Natural (leaving God out of the equation) are riddled with fear, doubt and insecurity.

- How can I overcome my addictions?
- How can I fix my marriage?
- · How can I afford to give?
- · What do I need to do to get out of debt?
- How can I keep sin out of my life?
- What will happen to ME if I ...?

When Living in the Natural, we can follow the same initial patterns as Moses. We RETREAT, RESIST, RUN.

God flips the script and all of the sudden He adds His Super to your Natural.

Read Exodus 3:14

Discuss or have someone share of a time that they experienced an answer or intervention from the SUPERnatural God

What makes us confident about the future is what God has done in the past.

Read Exodus 7:18

Moses not only wanted to remind the people, but remind them specifically of what God has done.

Discuss or have someone share about Journaling in their quiet time and how looking back on what God has done gives encouragement for the future.

Read Exodus 7:19-21

"Send the Hornet" means The God who goes before you. It reminds us that the way has been prepared for your success. Put a name to what God has already done for you - Send the Hornet... Go Before me... destroy my enemies. The phrase is found in 2 other passages pertaining to the same story... Jericho... Exodus 23 & Joshua 24.

When the Red Sea saw you, O God, its waters looked and trembled! The sea quaked to its very depths. The clouds poured down rain; the thunder rumbled in the sky. Your arrows of lightning flashed. Your thunder roared from the whirlwind; the lightning lit up the world! The earth trembled and shook. Your road led through the sea, your pathway through the mighty waters— a pathway no one knew was there! You led your people along that road like a flock of sheep, with Moses and Aaron as their shepherds. Psalms 77:16-20 NLT
