

Week 10 (03/10/24) Joshua DRIVE - Thru

The children of Israel had spent 430 years in slavery. They were released by God, into the care of a man named Moses. They were in the wilderness, and from there they go to the edge of the Promised Land.

- They were in Egypt... the Land of Not-Enough.
- They were in the wilderness, the Land of Just-Enough.
- God's desire and design was for them to be in the Land of More-Than-Enough.

Discuss - Compare the Three Stages of Israel over this almost 500 year period to our own lives and Spiritual Development / Growth. Some may be currently in a single stage or reflect on how God's provision has brought its through them collectively.

Read Joshua 1:13

God is allowing Moses to pass the baton to Joshua. Each stage needed the right leader and Joshua was God's choice for the conquering of the Promised Land.

Read Joshua 1:17

Under Moses, once the people followed him out of Egypt, they went nowhere for 40 yrs because of unbelief and **disobedience**. They were unqualified to receive it under the the Law, but in walks Joshua and he leads them to receive the land. What changed with this new generation? **They were obedient!**

Discuss - Review how God's promises always remain (Joshua 1:3), but our obedience may be hindering the timing of the delivery of those promises. God's Grace ensures the provision of His promises, but we still have to use Faith and Obedience to CLAIM IT!

If we could see the Promised Land, the turf he wants us to take by the square foot we wouldn't believe it. He has already given it to us, it's ours. **We're not fighting for victory, we're fighting from victory.** It's ours,

- · Do we have the character...
- Do we have the consistency...
- Do we have the commitment...
- Do we have the Guts...

The real question is do we have the **COURAGE**...

Courage is always fueled by faith. Our courage is only as strong as our faith. **Courage** means to **Stand** in the face of opposition. To stand for what is right. To stand for what is **Gods Way**.

Read Joshua 1:9

Discuss - Share or have someone in the LOOP share a time when an exhibition of courage was necessary to see what you knew to be God's promise come to fruition.

Whatever God starts, He finishes.

Close in prayer. Claim the promises of God and worship Him first.
